Fairy Forest

Follow these step-by-step instructions to make your own fashion doll fairy! Work from your imagination or use your favourite fairy images for inspiration.



You will need:

Supplies:

- 1 vinyl fashion doll, ready for a makeover
- Fabric flower(s)
- Narrow ribbon or embroidery floss
- Craft glue
- Glitter
- Laminating sheet (office supply stores offer this service)
- Heavy, clear fishing line

Equipment:

- Colour printer, or black only printer and some paints, coloured pens, or pencils
 - Scissors
 - Small brushes for glue, glitter, and paint
 - Big large-eye needle
- Optional (instructions found in other documents on this site):
- scissors, straws, pins, and paper towels for restyling hair
 - acrylic craft paint for face repainting

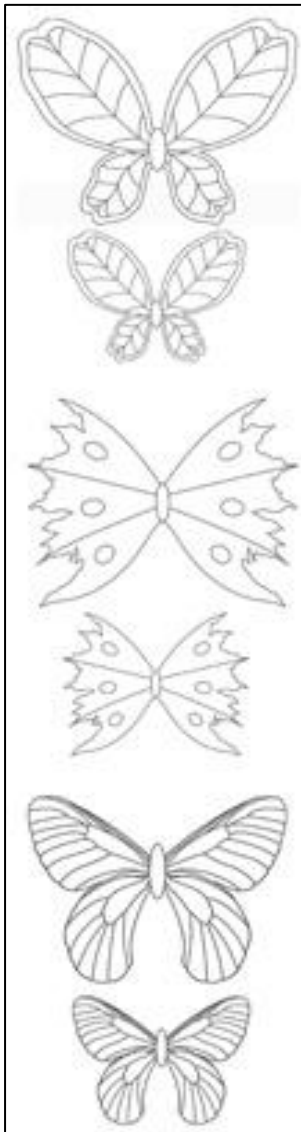


Select a suitable fashion doll, from your own collection or from your local thrift store, like these dolls on the left.

If required, clean up your future fairy with a little liquid dish soap or shampoo. Cream rinse or fabric softener will make it easier to comb her clean, wet hair.

Your doll might look perfect as is, but do not be afraid to try your hand at restyling her hair, or repainting her face a bit. (See the sections *Hair Styling* and *Repainting* for further information).

I chose this lovely little thrift store find as my model. I started by washing and drying this doll, combing and trimming her hair (just the uneven strands).
